PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE:

PAC EXECUTIVE UPDATE:

TREASURER'S UPDATE:

• \$6130.21 was in the gaming account as of September 23, 2025

- \$2984.07 was in the operating account as of September 23, 2025. \$183.65 paid for Sensory Bin equipment as agreed from last year.
- Teacher Requests for funds should be submitted to the Principal and Vice Principal for presentation and consideration of the PAC.
- LLC requested assistance with items to enhance the Scholastic Book Fair, PAC approved up to \$75 to be spent on items to make the book fair more appealing and fun.
- PAC requests a quote for Basketball jerseys to determine if we can pay for these as previously planned.
- LLC requested multiple items, PAC reviewed options as allowed under the gaming grant use of funds, PAC approved \$200 to go towards board games, card games & puzzles as these are used by all students in the LLC.
- Both the Arts & Pride clubs requested a combined \$600 for supplies and swag. PAC approved \$150 per club for supplies. Both clubs are welcome to resubmit later in the year for considerations, including specific needs for each and how they are helping the students that attend these clubs.
- A Grade 7 Leader has requested \$150 for their class for games/supplies specific for their class. PAC requests that Admin get all teachers to suggest what they might need from the PAC funds for their classes with a rough dollar amount. PAC hopes to look to make a contribution to all classes; however, the funds would need to be from the Operating Account and not the Gaming Account, fundraisers are essential in raising funds to assist needs within the classrooms.
